We are pleased to inform that the EIB – European Investment Bank has agreed to welcome an EBCAM's Private Sector Mission to their head quarters in Luxembourg, on November 8th, 2011.

The purpose of the Mission is to provide a deeper insight at the facilities offered by the Bank, the requirements necessary to introduce the projects. Special care will be given to eligibility including to the non EU investors willing to establish joint ventures in the African Countries.

The Staff of the Bank will available during the presentations and will answer relevant questions.

We are also pleased to inform that the Bank has accepted to welcome private companies accompanied by our Members. It is expected that these companies, enterprises and financial services, have concrete projects to design, or to implement, looking for finance. Maximum participation at the meeting will be 40 participants.
